Results

All schools are required by law to publish their pupil's results annually. In all types of schools these results are used as an important indicator of school effectiveness.

Pupils at the end of key stage three (at fourteen) are working across the early levels of our National Curriculum and are assessed by their teachers. Pupils at the end of key stage four (at sixteen) take a range of examinations, which include GCSE, GCSE Equivalent qualifications, Entry Level Certificates (these overlap with GCSE), specialist qualifications and vocational qualifications. Students in our Post 16 provisions study a range of functional and vocational qualifications.
